<u>WHEN FISH FLY</u> - 1,000 points Snap a selfie with this artwork before it swims away!



IN MEMORY - 600 points

It is widely reported that the first two fatalities from hostile fire during the Civil War were two young Lowell men. Visit the site that commemorates these men.



LOWELL IN A NUTSHELL - 1,000 points

Can you fit the Haffner's Gas Station, Lowell Sun, a legendary clock post, the mills, and nearly a thousand smiles in one picture? This art piece did.



<u>ALL ABOARD!</u> - 600 points

410 is about to leave the station! Snap a selfie before it moves onto its next destination.



HEAR ME ROAR - 1,000 points

Did you know that in 1843, Lowell High School became the first and oldest desegregated public high school in the United States? Learn more from the history marker at this location.



KIDS, DON'T TRY THIS AT HOME - 500 points

I'm a dragon, spinning fire through the air. Snap a picture of me while I am in action before the ice cools me down! Hint: you can only see me at night during WinterFest.



FIND YOUR CREATIVE SIDE - 500 points

The amount of creative IQ in this area would make Picasso faint! But not before he purchased a super cool glass mug. And a painting. And a hand-sculpted bowl.



ROAR! - 500 points

I'm big, fierce, and back from the Mesozoic Era to raise some merry mayhem with my sidekick human during WinterFest.



SHAZAM, HE'S BACK! - 500 points

l'm just a normal dude. Who can make a rabbit appear out of a hat. No big deal.



3... 2... 1... TIME'S UP! - 500 points

I'm cute, fuzzy, and share a name with an 1800s Lowell mill girl who became famous with her writing. Need another clue? I'll be wearing a festive outfit next to my City Council sidekick.



<u>DRAMATIC ENTRANCE</u> - 1,000 points Sure, arriving late to the party makes for a dramatic entrance, but you won't want to miss

this kick-off to the celebration!



<u>I'M NO LUMBERJACK...</u> - 400 points ...which probably explains my terrible aim during this sport. Give your arm a try!



ANYONE ELSE BORN IN 1891? - 600 points Maybe not "born," but Lowell did make me

official in that year. Inside my circle, you'll find a snapshot of Lowell's history, including the mills, a train, and a cornucopia full of fruit.



ALL FOR ME? - 600 points

What can I say, I'm pretty special. After my predecessor burned down in 1888, the City created Palmer Street in 1889 so that my workers can save lives faster. I've been enjoying the retired life since 1972 with a restaurant at my feet. Snap a picture of a clue that hints at my work prior to retirement.



BEEN THROUGH SOME CHANGES - 400 points

In 1892, I stood five stories tall. During the Great Depression, they removed my top three floors to reduce property taxes. In 1991, a fire gutted me. Thanks to some rehabilitation in 1993, I currently stand strong... well, maybe not my diet. What do you expect when I have delicious pizza available at my feet?



GETTING ICY IN HERE - 600 points

You may not be able to see any Zambonis from where you stand, but wish upon the flying blue star and maybe you'll find yourself in the NHL! Snap a pic of the front entrance of this building.



AN ABSURD ABUNDANCE OF ALLITERATION - 1,000 points

Tarry through this trial that tests the true theatrical, tuneful, and talented troubadours.



SINGING LOUD FOR ALL TO HEAR - 600 points

Just a pinch of folk music, a hint of New Orleans, and a whole bunch of party animals mixed together to get the music started on a fun note! Snap a pic of this band in action.



DO THESE 1878 SHOES LOOK GOOD ON ME? - 600 points

This building once held a prominent retail department store that offered six floors of kitchenware, appearel, fabric, musical products, and more until the building was turned into a Gordon Marsh branch in 1976. Look up and snap a picture of the 1878 retail store's name!



HONORARY PARK RANGER - 500 points

You'll be a professional park ranger by the end of this free drop-in session. Snap a picture with your decorated paper hat, then show off your new knowledge of how to identify animal tracks!
